The Table below is indicative of the standards required within our club

On Golf Courses

Note that Pro-shop staff and club management are given authority to deny a person's access to the golf courses if he / she considers their clothing or footwear is not acceptable

Men

Women

ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
Recognised golf specific attire Collared Sports Shirt Sports Shorts, Skirts or Skorts Tailored Pants Golf Shoes with Soft Spikes Clean and Tidy Sports Shoes Sport Socks	Swimming Attire Sandals, Thongs or Bare Feet Clothing displaying offensive words or motifs Singlets Shoes with metal spikes or heeled. Dirty or torn clothing

Clubhouses

Note that club management are given authority to deny a person's access to the club houses if he / she considers their clothing is not acceptable

ACCEPTABLE	NOT ACCEPTABLE
Neat casual dress is the minimum standard Golf course attire	Swimming Attire Bare Feet Caps, Visors and Hats Clothing displaying offensive words or motifs Singlets (After 6pm) Shoes with metal spikes Dirty or torn clothing

Children under 18:
